The program will involve guest presenters and industry experts, hands-on small-scale brewing, sensory assessment, and a full day training program at local commercial breweries.

In 1979, in the world recognised wine district of McLaren Vale, these two clubs had the vision and foresight to offer amateur wine and beer makers the opportunity to have their wines and beers not only be professionally judged, but also to compete against their peers. The venue has changed over the years, as had the ANAWBS Committee, number of entrants and their local and interstate addresses, as well as the number of classes of beer and wine, but the tradition of this National Show has seen the quality and standard of the beer and wine continuing to rise in standard. The Show has been a witness to the passion and wish of the entrants to improve the quality of their entries. The Judges, through their judging notes have repeatedly recognised with their positive views, the high standard of the wine and beer and the development and maturity of the entries.

In the event of a lack of entries in a particular class, those entries will be included in the nearest appropriate class or an amalgamated class. The Convenor may move an entry to another class if it is deemed that the entry is "Out of Class" if practicable.

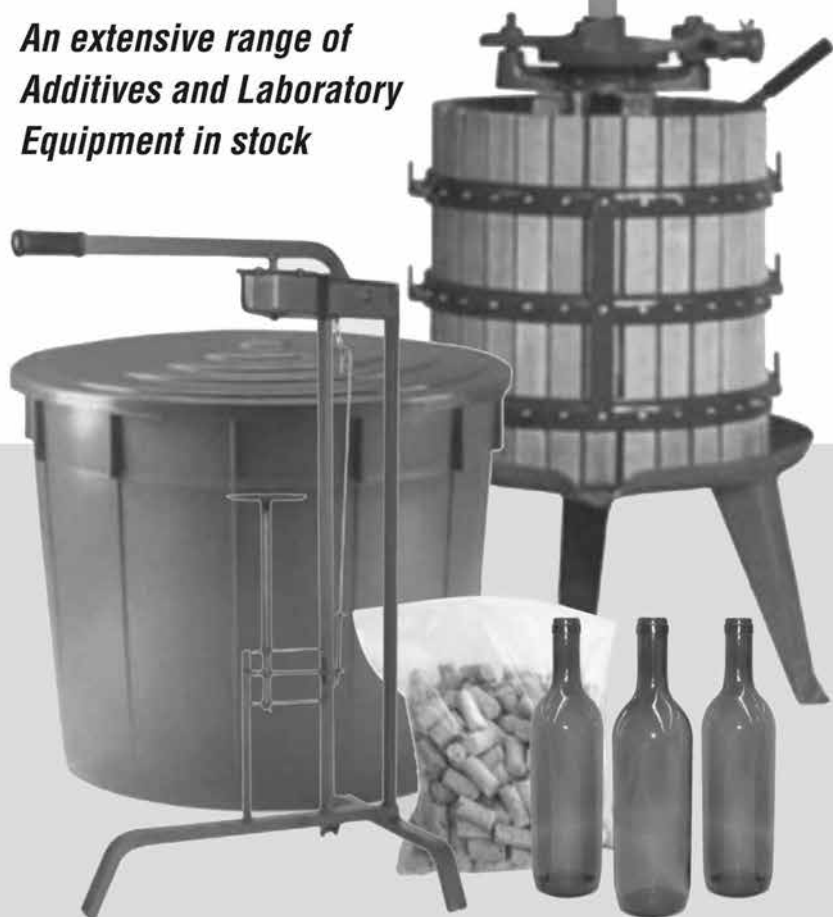

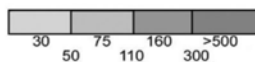
