He has won many awards for both over the past years. This year the beer competition schedule is the same as last year with a total of 16 classes. Mash Paddle

National All-Grain Brewer of the Year Competition



The popular mash paddle competition will again feature as part of the beer competition. This competition is open to all full mash brewers. The beer style for 2017 competition is American Brown Ale, BJCP style 10C. Last years winner was Grant Morley a brewer from Victoria with his German Pils which was awarded a bronze medal. Grant was also awarded the trophy for Most Successful Brewer with an average score of 40.5 over 5 classes.

Medals, Certificates and Trophies

ANAWBS entries are judged and points awarded using the 20 point system for wine and the 50 point system for beer.

Medals are awarded to exhibitors who achieve the following scores.



	Wine	Beer
Gold	18.5 to 20.0 Pts	45.0 to 50.0 Pts
Silver	17.0 to 18.4 Pts	40.0 to 44.9 Pts
Bronze	15.5 to 16.9 Pts	35.0 to 39.9 Pts

Certificates are also awarded to all place getters in the beer and wine classes.

Trophies are awarded to the top medal winning beers or wines for each class and measure the success of an exhibitor in a given class against their peers.

Special Trophies Awarded are:

Best Wine of the Show, Best Beer of the Show, Best Kit Beer of the Show, The Mash Paddle Competition,

Most Successful Grape Winemaker and Brewer of the Year.

All results are published on our web site as well as in a souvenir results book which is posted to every entrant.
