## Beer Classes

Open to all kit, modified kit, partial or full mash amateur brewers.

This competition has 16 beer classes covering most popular varieties of beer.

“Mash Paddle” full grain mash competition.

The popular mash paddle competition will again feature as part of the beer competition. This competition is open to all full mash brewers. The beer style for 2019 competition is Belgian Ale – BJCP class 24 and 25

## Wine Classes

Open to all amateur winemakers. This competition has 24 wine classes for all varieties of wine - sparkling , white, red, liqueurs fortifiés and cider.

## Major Trophies and Medals

### Medals

Gold, Silver and Bronze medals are awarded based upon the merit of the wine or beer in each class.

### Class Trophies

Trophies will be awarded to the top medal winning entry for each class.

Certificates are awarded to First, Second and Third in each class.
